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

PROJECT DESCRIPTION FOR EAST VICTORIA RESERVOIR

Padre Dam Municipal Water District (District) is proposing to replace the existing East Victoria Reservoir with a new, 125-foot-diameter, circular pre-stressed concrete reservoir, which incorporates a flat, gravel covered, concrete roof. Similar to the existing reservoir, the proposed reservoir will feature a low-profile design and will be semi-buried (the reservoir tank and roof will be between approximately 1 to 2 feet above grade) and will increase storage capacity by approximately 1 million gallons for a total capacity of 2.3 million gallons to meet current and planned future demands.

The new reservoir will incorporate a pre-stressed construction system and will be located such that the construction excavation limit is within the District's property.

A new electric-powered pump station will be constructed north of the existing pump station in a four-walled, tile-roofed, masonry block enclosure. The facility will be equipped with an estimated 230-kilowatt (kW) outdoor, diesel-powered engine, emergency generator to provide electrical service to operate any two pumps simultaneously and will be located within a self-contained, weatherproof and sound-attenuated enclosure next to the new pump station. The emergency generator will incorporate a 215-gallon, double-walled diesel fuel tank. Once the new pump station is complete, the existing pump station will be demolished.

A masonry retaining wall will be constructed southeast of the reservoir, between the proposed concrete drainage ditch adjacent to the new pump station and the 1:1 side slope on the eastern side of the reservoir.

New paving will add an additional 13,400 square feet of impervious surface area to the site and result in a minor (approximately 0.6 cubic-feet-per-second) increase in runoff.

Nine ornamental trees located north of the reservoir will be removed.

Also, due to the presence of granitic rock underlying the project site, some blasting may be required during excavation at the deeper depths of excavation. Therefore, the drilling and blasting is expected to generally occur in the bottom of the excavation area.

The District, through standard design and construction practices, has incorporated numerous project design features and construction measures into the project that reduce the potential for environmental effects. Construction will be performed by qualified contractors. The contract documents, plans, and specifications will incorporate stipulations regarding standard county requirements and acceptable construction practices including, but not limited to, grading and demolition, safety measures, vehicle operation and maintenance, erosion control, dust control, noise generation, blasting, air quality emissions, seismic safety parameters, the use and storage of hazardous materials, and water quality.

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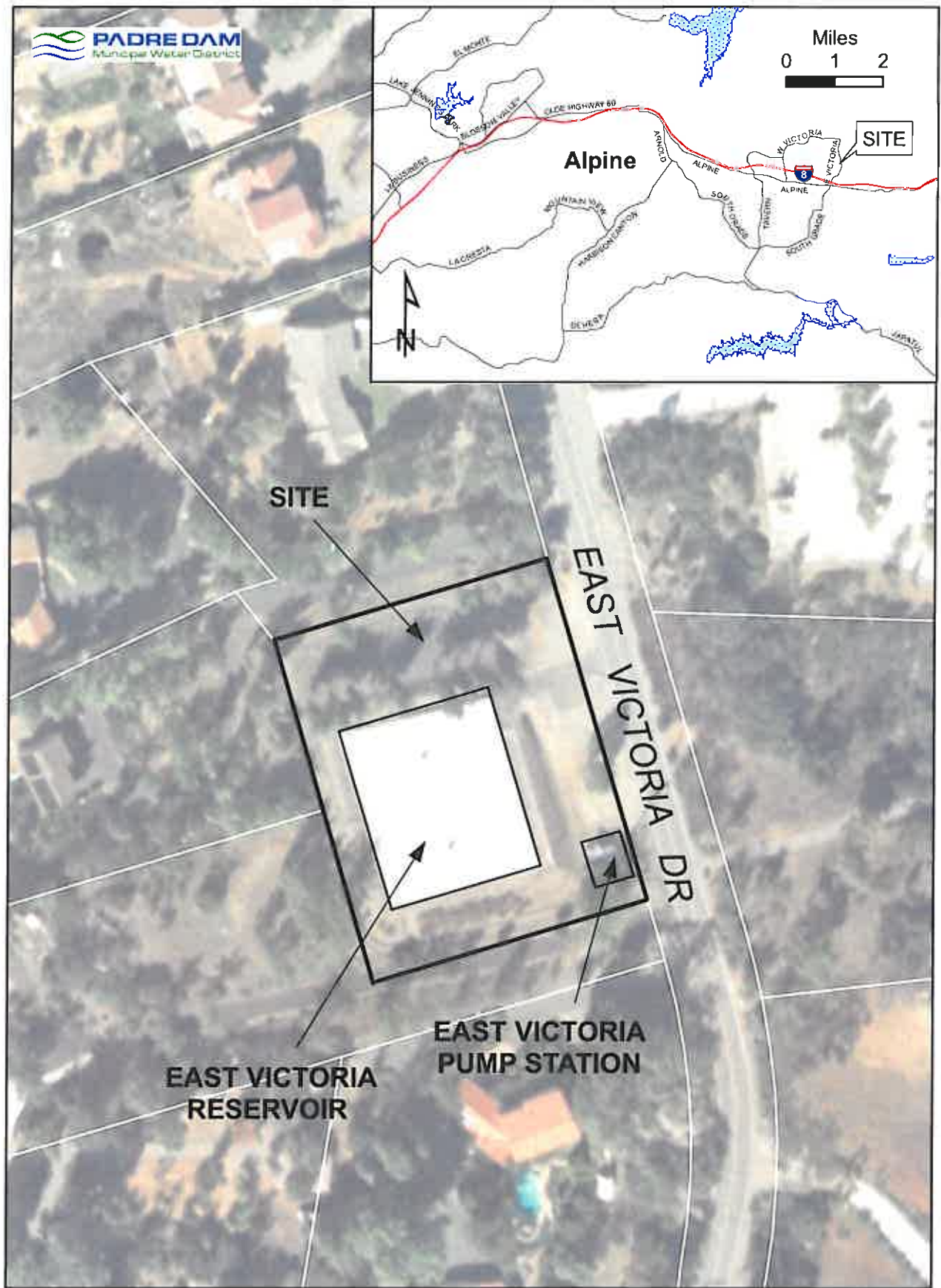
