## Level 2 Drought Alert

*When can I irrigate in Level 2?*

Here's what Padre Dam's Drought Ordinance requires:

- 1.** In Level 2, residential and commercial landscape irrigation is limited to no more than three (3) assigned days per week on a schedule established and posted by Padre Dam.
- 2.** During the months of December through March, landscape irrigation is limited to no more than two (2) assigned days per week on a schedule established and posted by Padre Dam.
- 3.** Lawn watering and landscape irrigation using sprinklers is limited to no more than ten (10) minutes per watering station per assigned day.
- 4.** This ten minute limit does not apply to water efficient devices, including but not limited to: weather based controllers, drip/micro-irrigation systems and stream rotor sprinklers.
- 5.** If you do not have an irrigation system, you can water landscape, trees and shrubs with a bucket, hand-held hose with positive shut-off nozzle, or low-volume non-spray irrigation equipment, if you follow the same schedule set forth above for irrigation systems.

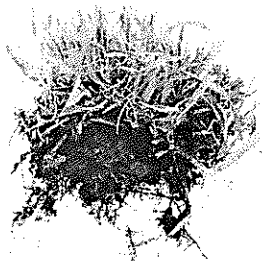
**Note:** these restrictions do not apply to commercial growers or nurseries.

*Are there any other restrictions in Level 2?*

- 1.** "All the time" water waste restrictions are still in effect and will be enforced.
- 2.** Customers must repair leaks within seventy-two (72) hours of notification by Padre Dam unless other arrangements are made with the General Manager. Severe leaks must be stopped immediately.
- 3.** Stop operating ornamental fountains or similar decorative water features unless recycled water is used.
- 4.** Water used for construction purposes within Padre Dam's service area, such as dust control or soil compaction, must be recycled or non-potable water, when it is available.
